Our Privacy Policy forms part of and must be read in conjunction with, website Terms and Conditions. We reserve the right to change this Privacy Policy at any time.

We respect the privacy of our users and every person who visits our sites **www.pxcode.io**. Here, **PxCode Inc.** (“company”, “we”, “us”, or “our”). We are committed to protecting your personal information and your right to privacy. If you have any questions or concerns about our policy or our practices with regards to your personal information, please contact us at **info@pxcode.io**.

When you visit our website **www.pxcode.io** (“Site”), and use our services, you trust us with your personal information. Our Privacy policy seeks to protect your privacy in every possible way. Our privacy policy will explain to you clearly what information we collect, how we use it, and what rights you have concerning it. We hope you take some time to read through it carefully, as it is important. If there are any terms in this privacy policy that you do not agree with, please discontinue the use of our site and our services.

This privacy policy applies to all information collected through our website, and/or any related services, sales, marketing, or events (we refer to them collectively in this privacy policy as the “**Site**”).

At www.pxcode.io, we provide a meticulously designed website that allows you to edit the design draft imported from the SKETCH file to the pxCode editor.

We provide you the functionality to convert your application (“User Application”) into a format that is compatible with the relevant iOS, Android, and other software platforms. Users can generate quality codes to build responsive websites/ applications.

This website also enables you to invite a limited (or unlimited, if your Subscription Plan permits) number of your colleagues, friends, family, or others to collaborate and propose changes or edits to the User Applications related to a particular project or projects for which you invite them (each such Authorized User who is invited to contribute to a project is called a “Team Member” for that Project). Users can invite anyone to the team by email, they need to subscribe to more team space before inviting teammates by obtaining corresponding Subscription plan.

Please read this privacy policy carefully as it will help you make informed decisions about sharing your personal information with us.

1. WHAT INFORMATION DO WE COLLECT?

The personal information you disclose to us

We collect personal information that you voluntarily provide to us when registering with us, expressing an interest in obtaining information about us or our services, when participating in activities on the Site, or otherwise contacting us.

We collect personal information under our Website's terms and conditions. The personal information includes the choices you make, and the Services and features you use. The personal information we collect can include the following:

Name and Contact Data. We collect your first and last name, email address, Google account access, and other similar contact data.

Credentials. We collect passwords, password hints, and similar security information used for authentication and account access.

Payment Data. We collect data necessary to process your payment if you make purchases, such as your payment instrument number (such as a credit card number), and the security code associated with your payment instrument.

Communications with Us. We may collect Personal Information from you, such as your email address, when you choose to request information about our Services, register for our newsletter, or a loyalty program that we may offer from time to time, request to receive customer or technical support or otherwise communicate with us.

Surveys. From time to time, we may contact you to participate in online surveys. If you do decide to participate, you may be asked to provide certain information which may include Personal Information. All information collected from your participation in our surveys is provided by you voluntarily. We may use such information to improve our products and/or Services and in any manner consistent with the policies provided herein.

Posting on the Services. We may offer publicly accessible pages, blogs, private messages, or community forums. Information automatically collected

We automatically collect certain information when you visit, use, or navigate the Site. We use the information we collect or receive:

5. IS YOUR INFORMATION TRANSFERRED INTERNATIONALLY?
